Mastering Initial /R/ Directions

Lesson 10:

1. Explain to students that now this is the last lesson for mastering initial /r/. They are going to be using /r/ with many different types of words.

2. Teach initial /r/ with a variety of words: bilabial, multi-syllabic, mixed. Use the pictures and the video lesson to demonstrate.

3. Have students practice /r/ with mixed words.


4. Give student the laminated practice page. For each picture that they touch (or cover with a bingo chip), practice /r/ words.

5. Send the student home with the worksheet to practice their new /r/ plus word endings in front of a mirror at home.


LESSON 10: SAY THE MULTI-SYLLABIC WORD WITH BILABIALS
