Lesson 4:

1. Tell students that now we are going to add more sounds to our puffy tongue. We are going to start with our puffy tongue "a" and add short vowels.

2. Teach making a puffy tongue "a" and sliding your voice into a short "a". Repeat for the other vowels. Use the picture and the video lesson to demonstrate.


3. Have students practice sliding their puffy tongue "a" into each vowel.

4. Give student the laminated practice page. For each picture that they touch (or cover with a bingo chip), practice another puffy tongue with vowel.


7. Send the student home with the worksheet to practice their puffy tongue in front of a mirror at home.

Hold your puffy tongue with "a" and slide into each long vowel sound.




Each time that you correctly slide from puffy tongue to the vowel, cross off one mouth.
