
Set up an account and enroll in the free class called "Mastering /R/". Bookmark the class on your computer or iPad so that you can reference it with students.

Lesson 6:


- 1. Explain to students that now it is time to magically shape that puffy tongue "a" into an "R" sound. See the video for a demonstration.

Shape your puffy tongue "a" into an "R" sound. Slide into each word ending.




Each time that you correctly slide from "R" to the word ending, cross off one mouth.
