2. Teach making /r/ with bilabial words. Use the pictures and the video lesson to demonstrate.


3. Have students practice /r/ words with bilabials.


4. Give student the laminated practice page. For each picture that they touch (or cover with a bingo chip), practice /r/ with bilabials.

7. Send the student home with the worksheet to practice their new /r/ plus word endings in front of a mirror at home.


LESSON 9: SAY THE 1-SYLLABLE WORD WITH BILABIALS

Say each word with your new "R" sound.






Each time that you correctly say the word with your new R sound, cross off the picture.



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
